## AMAZONIA – FASCINATION TROPICAL RAINFOREST

The view from the visitor platform opens up like a clearing in the 360°Panorama AMAZONIA far into the Amazon landscape: up to the treetops, gigantic jungle trees, unique plants in all of them. Shades of green and numerous animals of the region.

AMAZONIA is artist Yadegar Asisi's hyperrealistic interpretation of the diverse geological creations that make up the tropical rainforest, depicted in an incredible level of detail.

Asisi traveled to the Amazon four times in order to take in the genius loci and develop the concept for the rainforest Panorama, resulting in tens of thousands of photos and countless sketches and watercolors that were used to create the artwork.

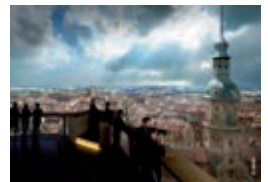
## PANOMETER DRESDEN

Embark on a unique journey not far from the Great Garden and experience unique panoramic art. The 27-metre-high circular masterpiece created by Yadegar Asisi has been a gem of insider knowledge among Dresden museum and exhibition experts since 2006.

Presented in a former gasometer, the extraordinary panoramas thanks to audiovisual effects in day and night as well as a 1:1 view from the 15-metre-high visitor tower extremely real and vivid.

Previously the two city-related and historical giant panoramas DRESDEN IM BAROCK or DRESDEN 1945 could be marvelled at alternately, now comes a magical image of nature in the industrial monument.

The 360° panorama **DRESDEN IM BAROCK** takes you back to the Dresden's Baroque period between 1695 and 1760. Under August the Strong and his son, the Dresden court experienced a splendid and artistic development. From the tower of the Court Church, the view sweeps over squares and alleyways with the Royal Palace and the Zwinger, over churches and palaces to Dresden's new town.



**DRESDEN 1945 – Tragedy and Hope of a European City** focusses on the themes of war and destruction as a result of the devastating air strikes on Dresden in February 1945. Along with a number of other European cities that were destroyed in the Second World War, Dresden has become a global symbol of the annihilation of war.
