GETTING THERE

BY TRAM 1 2

Line 1 and 2 (in both directions), get off at the "Liebäder Straße" stop, approx. 10 minutes by foot to Liebäder Straße, then take Winterbergstraße onto Gasanstaltstraße

BY S-BAHN 1 2

Line 1 and 2 (in both directions), get off at "Dresden Reick" stop, approx. 5 – 10 minutes by foot

BY BUS 64

Line 64, get off at "Nätherstraße" stop, the bus stops directly in front of the Panometer

GREAT BARRIER REEF – WORLD OF CORAL

With Great Barrier Reef, Yadegar Asisi tackles one of the Earth's greatest natural wonders. The monumental 360° panorama reveals the fascinating underwater world of the planet's largest coral reef in overwhelming detail and intense color. Visitors dive into a world that is often hidden from them—shimmering corals, vibrant schools of fish, and the mysterious light plays of the ocean depths unfold at a height of 27 meters and over 3,000 square meters of panorama.

The work is based on tens of thousands of underwater photographs and sketches that Asisi collected on several expeditions with Australian documentary filmmaker Ben Cropp. A specially composed soundscape by Eric Babak accompanies the visual staging: atmospheric sounds, music, and a day-to-night light transition immerse visitors completely in the underwater world.

Alongside the panorama, the Panometer Dresden offers an exhibition with information about the biodiversity and ecological significance of the Great Barrier Reef. The exhibition also addresses the increasing threat to this unique natural habitat—from climate change to the consequences of human interventions.



PANOMETER DRESDEN

Embark on a unique journey not far from the Great Garden and experience unique panoramic art. The 27-metre-high circular masterpiece created by Yadegar Asisi has been a gem of insider knowledge among Dresden museum and exhibition experts since 2006.

Presented in a former gasometer, the extraordinary panoramas thanks to audiovisual effects in day and night as well as a 1:1 view from the 15-metre-high visitor tower extremely real and vivid.

Until now, the Panometer Dresden has alternated between two city-related, historically significant giant panoramic artworks: DRESDEN BAROQUE and DRESDEN 1945. In 2024, AMAZONIA was presented for the first time. Now, look forward to a second nature panorama set within the impressive industrial monument.
