GETTING THERE

BY TRAM 1 2

Line 1 (towards Prohlis) and 2 (towards Kleinschwitz), get off at the "Liebstädter Straße" stop, approx. 10 minutes by foot to Liebstädter Straße, then take Winterbergstraße onto Gasanstaltstraße

BY S-BAHN 1 2

Line 1 and 2 (in both directions), get off at "Dresden Reick" stop, approx. 5–10 minutes by foot

BY BUS 64

Line 64, get off at "Nätherstraße" stop
The bus stops directly in front of Panometer Dresden

THE MYTH OF THE ROYAL CITY OF SAXONY

The huge panorama at Panometer Dresden presents the state capital of Saxony, Dresden, during its most famous era – Baroque. On a 1:1 scale, you will discover a unique complete view (105 x 27 metres in size) of the royal city as it was between 1695 and 1760. The breathtaking 360° panorama created by Yadegar Asisi focuses on the exuberant lifestyle of those living in the Baroque town, capturing the ambiance by depicting personalities such as Casanova and Johann Sebastian Bach.

Ascend to the top of the 15-metre high tower to enjoy a magnificent view of historic Dresden and experience the town as it changes from day to night in front of your very eyes. In a dazzling display of pink, blue and gold, the accompanying exhibition prepares you for this exceptional Panorama artwork.

PANOMETER DRESDEN

Embark on a once in a lifetime journey through Dresden's past and experience the town as a 360° panorama, all just a short distance away from the renowned Großer Garten. The 27-metre tall circular masterpiece created by Yadegar Asisi has been a gem of insider knowledge among Dresden museum and exhibition experts since 2006.

Displayed in a former gasometer, audio-visual effects have been employed to make the unique panoramas come to life as the images change from day to night. You can also experience the city from a 1:1 view on a 15-metre tall tower where the city looks as real as ever.
